»»» PROJECT UPDATES

The STELLA project partners held the first online meeting on June 27, 2024, hosted by the Italian coordinator TDM 2000 ODV, to present the project, discuss key project updates and financial logistics, and prepare for the upcoming Kick-Off Meeting (KoM) in Cagliari, Sardinia from July 18-21, 2024. In addition, throughout the meeting, the representatives of the partners' organizations discussed some arrangements for the project's implementation and timeline.

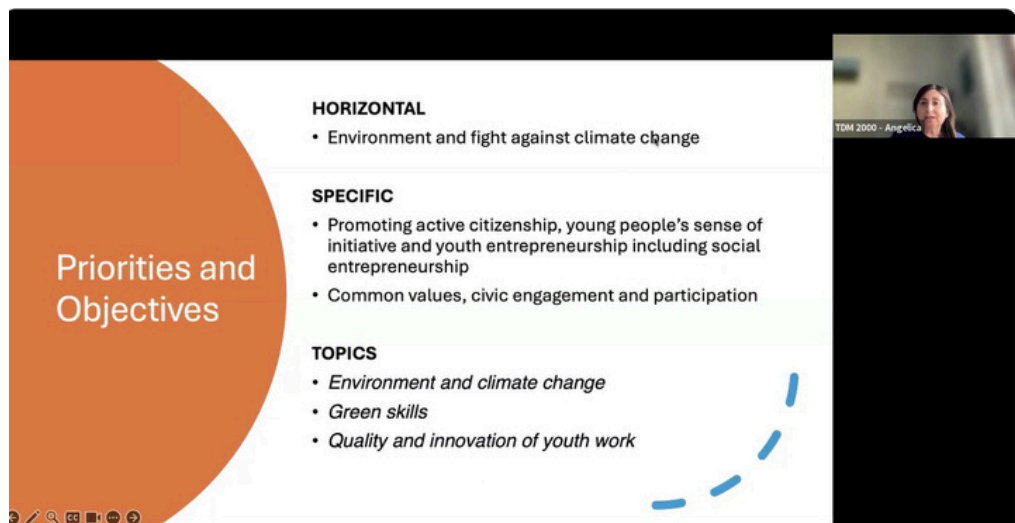
Concrete results

- A Toolkit on Environmental Sustainability Education through Sport Activities, containing both best practices and existing projects and tools as an inspiration (at least 75), inspiring talks (10), and a training kit and ready-made workshops for different age groups to use sport for Environmental Sustainability Education.

The manual will be both in printed and digital version and available in 5 languages.

It will be printed in 150 copies and downloaded at least 300 times





Here are the main points covered:

Introductions: Each partner presented themselves and their organizations. Partners were reminded to upload their presentations and logos in the designated project drive for future use.

Project Overview: A detailed presentation on the STELLA project was shared, focusing on upcoming tasks, timelines, and roles. Partners were encouraged to review their responsibilities outlined in the application to ensure feasibility.

KoM Preparations: The partners will attend the KoM, where task coordinators will facilitate interactive activities to gather input and present draft guidelines for their assigned responsibilities.

Sustainability Discussions: The group discussed ways to minimize environmental impact during the project, such as reducing the number of printed materials and using recycled paper for the training kit (WP2). Partners are encouraged to explore other sustainable options.

Looking ahead, the KoM will include a Kick-Off Conference and further discussions on the timeline for the training of trainers.
