KICK-OFF MEETING IN ITALY

At the Kick-off Meeting on July 19th-20th, hosted by TDM 2000 ODV in Sardinia, Italy. The meeting included the partners TDM 2000 Malta, AZO, Synergia, and EKO. It outlined the project's objectives, timeline, and work packages (WPs). Presentations covered essential topics such as project guidelines, dissemination strategies, and risk assessment activities. The meeting emphasized each partner's responsibility in implementing their assigned tasks and creating guidelines for deliverables and internal communication.

The meeting also discussed financial and administrative management, stressing the importance of adhering to the budget and guidelines. Any changes to the work packages or budget require formal amendments, and partners were reminded to ensure data protection and maintain compliance with the grant agreement.

The first press conferences were implemented in the partner countries, where the partners introduced the project and its expected outcomes. The conferences began with opening remarks and an overview of the initiative. The partner organizations presented the project's goals, strategies, and expected outcomes, emphasizing our partners' collaborative support.

Panel discussions focused on the project's topic. Last but not least, it was decided that the next TPM will be in December, in Athens. The TPM's date will be decided soon.

These events come within the framework of implementing the STELLA "Sport as a Tool for Environmental Sustainability Learning project, which includes 5 organizations from 5 European countries and runs for 24 months from March 1, 2024, to February 28, 2026. Those organizations are the coordinator TDM 2000 ODV- Italy, TDM 2000- Malta, Active Zone Outdoor-Cyprus, SYAJ - Associacao Juvenil Synergia- Portugal, and EKO- Greece. S.T.E.L.L.A is a KA2 project funded by the Erasmus + Programme of the European Union.
